On November 2, 2021, Travis Heinze came into City Hall at approximately 9:15 AM. Upon entering the building, Mr. Heinze began a repeated inquiry to City Hall staff about parking regulations and parking availability in the immediate area. City Hall staff attempted to answer his questions.

As the conversation progressed, City Hall staff became concerned and uncomfortable. The police department was called to City Hall as a security measure for the City Hall staff.

Upon arriving at City Hall, a City of Bethany police officer questioned Mr. Heinze. Mr. Heinze refused to identify himself. Mr. Heinze was placed on a 24-hour investigative hold at the Harrison County Detention Center.

Mr. Heinze was subsequently charged with disturbing the peace and second-degree harassment by the Prosecutor's Office. Those charges have been dismissed as of November 4, 2021.
